A sales tax check was received for \$37,017 and a reimbursement from the County for the building project of \$39,200. A motion was made and support given to receive the report and place it on file. Passed.

ASSESSOR'S REPORT: No report this month. The next Board of Review will be held on March 15 & 16 at the Sturges Young Auditorium.

ROAD WORK UPDATE: The contract for work to be done on Witt Lake Road has been signed and submitted to the Road Commission.

CEMETERY: We will be collecting bids for fencing Sanborn Cemetery as soon as the tree are cleaned up.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The next meeting is January 15<sup>th</sup>. They will be considering an ordinance concerning tiny houses, catching up on documentation and election of officers.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: The FD completed updates on all the Standard Operating Procedures. They are 100% caught up on reporting.

AMBULANCE: The next meeting is February 16<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m.
